



Online/Blended Learning

The Blended Learning Courses offer the convenience of online training in combination with skills sessions coordinated with the American Red Cross Badger Chapter. The first portion of the course, including the written exam, is online and can be taken from any computer with Internet access. The second part of the training, the skill practice and assessment, is conducted by a Red Cross instructor in a classroom setting. Red Cross Blended Learning is flexible, self-paced and available online 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Students have the option of going through the lessons in a full or abbreviated format and can test out of lessons. Web-based training enables course-takers to access courses at their convenience and minimizes schedule conflicts with work-related responsibilities. Classes may include Adult, Child, Infant CPR, First Aid and Adult or Child AED. Interested individuals must have access to a high speed computer to complete the online portion. Please allow a maximum of 4 weeks between the online session and skills portion of the training. Supported Operating Systems: Windows 2000, XP, or Vista. Internet Browsers: IE 6.0 or higher, Firefox 2.0 or higher.

Standard First Aid with CPR/AED - Adult and CPR - Child and Infant

This course gives individuals the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic care for breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants until advanced medical personnel come and take over as well as an overview of first aid. Individuals will also learn how to provide care for an adult in sudden cardiac arrest through the safe use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). Skills covered include controlling bleeding; caring for muscle, bone and joint injuries; treating burns; and responding to shock.
